MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- NPE Contract and Catastrophic Aid Data
- New submission window
- April 1 to April 30

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Indicator 20 clarification
 - February 28 – December 1 collection window closes. All verifications and discrepancies must be resolved. Subsequent changes to data will result in loss of points for indicator 2
 - September 15 – June EOY collection window closes. All verifications and discrepancies must be resolved. Subsequent changes to data will result in loss of points for indicator 20

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- File Specification Change
 - Ethnicity and racial categories will be collected in 2 separate fields.
 - Import and export routines will need to be modified to account for fields 8 (ethnic group) and 9 (racial category). Increasing the header record to 22 fields.
 - There are no changes to the set(s) of service line data amended to the student header record.

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Security Issue
 - Attaching confidential student data to e-mail messages is in violation of KSDE's security policy.

 - Page iv addresses this issue. Failure to comply may result in loss on Indicator 20 points for not following instructions.

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Introduction of new terminology
 - Familiarize project staff with field titles that will change in the KAN_Service application
 - Organization = Affiliation / level of relationship
 - Coop / Interlocal
 - District / Agency, D0, S0, X0
 - Building
 - Attendance building = Service Location
 - Funding Code = Eligibility Code

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- New Race and Ethnicity Categories
 - Two separate fields – Same format as the KIDS collection. Planned interface with LEAMIS.
 - Hispanic or Latino – Y for yes, N for no
 - Racial Categories – select all that apply
 - American Indian or Alaskan Native
 - Asian
 - Black or African American
 - Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander
 - White

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- New Race and Ethnicity Categories
 - Determined by parent or self declaration upon enrollment
 - Refused to designate
 - In accordance with agency policy of determination by observer identification
 - All student must be reclassified for the FY2010 school year. Existing MIS values will not be migrated into the new categories.

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Settings for virtual students
 - For student receiving SPED support in virtual programs
 - Participation in virtual program from home = A - home-based setting
 - Participation in virtual program in district buildings / classrooms = H – Alternative school setting
 - Participation in virtual program at other locations = D – non school setting
 - Public libraries, internet café, community center, etc.

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Status Codes
 - D - Drop out – OSEP definition which includes moved, not known to be continuing
 - U - Moved, not know to be continuing – no longer an option
 - W – Written revocation of services – with evidence of continuing in general education
 - A – Action initiated withdraw from SPED – with evidence of continuing in general education
 - W & A count in the OSEP category of Return to regular ed

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Status Codes
- I - Reinitiation of Services – IDEA students who have had all of their services revoked and services are resuming this school year.
 - Given – initial consent for services must have been established and IEP completed. Typically at least 1 day of services would be reported on MIS prior to revocation, unless original IEP was never implemented.
 - Data needed to report this status
 - New evaluation (date)
 - New IEP (date)
 - See matrix

MIS Data Dictionary Changes

- Reporting Early Childhood Services
 - Accounting for full sessions in SPED programs
 - Reverse mainstream classroom
 - Integrated SPED classroom
- Participation in Regular Early Childhood programs
 - Examples of what portions of the day qualify as K-Time
 - Addresses recess, meal times, etc.
 - Kindergarten - 26 / 71 LEAs report KG students with K time

Status of the MIS project

- Anticipated Last year for the LEAMIS application
- KAN_Service is in the testing phase
 - A group of pilots will be selected for an initial phase of testing.
 - FY2010 all agencies will have the opportunity to use the application as part of training exercises.
 - FY2010 all agencies will be asked to enter actual student data into KAN_Service as part of validation checks.
- Alignment of MIS and KIDS unit of record data

Status of the MIS project

- Changes in KAN_Service
 - Multi - user
 - More than 1 individual can access the application
 - Access levels are designated by local director.
 - Read only
 - Full access to read and edit records
 - Notification of transfer
 - If a transfer in student (in KAN_Service) is claimed in the KIDS system, receiving LEA is alerted
 - If a transfer out student (in KAN_Service) is claimed by a new LEA, exiting LEA is alerted

Status of the MIS project

- Changes in KAN_Service
 - Building profile changes
 - Data is pulled from the state directory. Only one place for building data. Updates are made in the directory. No exchange of BP information
 - Generic building numbers 99xx will be retired.
 - All buildings will have a 4 digit number in the directory
 - Calendar changes
 - A single calendar table in KAN_Service holds all calendars. No exchange of calendars

Status of the MIS project

- Changes in KAN_Service
 - No paper exchange of verifications
 - All corrections, modifications and confirmation of discrepancies are done in the application
 - Generic building numbers 99xx will be retired.
 - All buildings will have a 4 digit number in the directory
 - Calendar changes
 - A single calendar table in KAN_Service holds all calendars. No exchange of calendars

- Mason's Role - Continue to provide assistance to improve the quality and accuracy of 618 data reported to KSDE in terms of:
 - The content of the data reported
 - Publishing data standards and requirements
 - Training of local MIS staff

 - Documenting accurate MIS practices and procedures in local Procedural Manuals.
